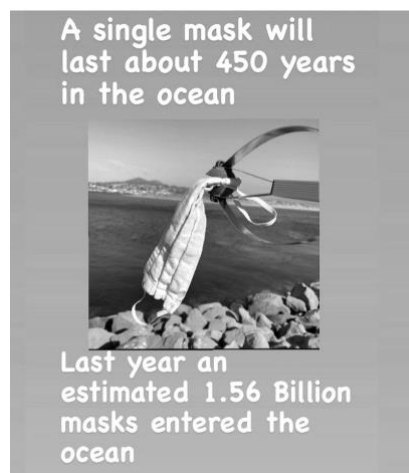
### RTN Heather Environment Chair
