

In early 1944 the news that the first breeding of the platypus in captivity had taken place at Healesville Sanctuary caused a great sensation. We Breed the Platypus, written by Sanctuary Director David Fleay - the person responsible for the successful outcome - described the story of Corrie and proud parents Jack and Jill. This 52-page illustrated booklet was a huge best-seller at the time, treasured in thousands of Australian households.

#### "JOIN MERRI CREEK BIRDWATCH: LEARN. EXPLORE. AND ENJOY NATURE'S BEAUTY"

Our next Merri Creek <u>BirdWatch</u> surveys are coming up soon - on Sunday 16 February and Sunday 23 Februaryfrom 8:45 – 10:30am.

There are ten sites to choose from. Meeting points are listed below, and there is more information (including <u>maps</u>of the survey routes) on the <u>FoMC website</u>. Choose a site near you to learn more about your local birds, or explore a different part of the Merri. Beginner-birders are welcome to our surveys, as well as experienced birders.

Bring binoculars if you have them, and closed-in footwear, sun hat or raingear if necessary, and drinking water. No dogs, please. Keep an eye out for snakes, especially if walking through grass near water.

No need to register beforehand, unless you are going to the galgi ngarrk survey (see below). Note Parks Victoria require a Working With Children Check for volunteers on Parks Vic-managed land, including galgi ngarrk and bababi marning.

Please don't attend if you're feeling unwell and have any cold or flulike symptoms.

At all times, children must be under the direct supervision of their parent or guardian.
